Family Survey Results

We are very happy and pleased to announce that the recent Archway Glendale Family Surveys were very positive. In fact, we enjoyed the highest family satisfaction rating in the entire Great Hearts network, and that is really saying something! There were two items more than one parent mentioned for improvement:

- 1. Consistency in R&R weekend homework expectations: We have reminded teachers that students should not be tested or have papers due on the day back to school following R&R.
- 2. A perceived homework increase from 2nd to 3rd grade. The 2nd and 3rd grade teams are meeting to compare notes and make adjustments if necessary. There should be an increased amount of time and depth of inquiry from 2nd to 3rd, but the increase needs to be modest.

Parents monitoring their children's homework is critical in a successful school-family partnership. Please do not hesitate to contact the teacher if homework time seems too long or too short, or if your student is having difficulty understanding concepts. Reading at home to your student and having your student read to you is our top priority. Practicing and mastering math facts is probably the next highest priority.

We are so blessed to be able to partner with you in forming hearts and minds in virtue and truth, and delighted that you, our parents, are highly satisfied with your experience of our school learning community.
