Mandatory Winter Concert - 11/30

Please mark your calendars! All students are required to perform in the Winter Concert on November 30th.

The kindergarten, 1st, and 2nd grade concert will begin at 5 pm and end at 5:45 pm. The 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade concert will begin at 6:15 pm and end at 7 pm. Students are required to stay for the entire concert to prevent disruptions. Please do not attempt to pick up your student before the concert has ended.

Concert attire for kindergarten through 4th grade is a clean school uniform. Shorts are not allowed. Sweaters and sweatshirts may not be worn while performing. If your child wears one to the concert, please keep it with you at your seat. Concert attire for our 5th graders is black and white dress attire. Boys should wear a white collared shirt with black dress slacks and black dress shoes. Ties are optional. Girls should wear a white blouse with a black skirt or black dress slacks and black dress shoes. A modest black dress is acceptable, as well. Open-toed shoes and reasonable heels are permitted.

Thank you for supporting our Fifth Annual Read A Thon! What a support to the reading success of our students!

Our **strengthen support for student success** tip of the week is:

Read every night to your students and have them read aloud to you. If their expression is not what it should be, if there is a word they do not know, or if they run past the punctuation, enthusiastically and positively have them do it again – “Hey, I think we can do that even better! Let’s read it together with expression and then you read it again.”

Have students read short passages aloud, one or two sentences at a time, not a whole paragraph. You can read longer passages aloud together with your student.
