## Archway Glendale Re-Enrollment

Re-enrollment for current Archway Glendale students in kindergarten through 4th grade will begin on March 1st, but you can make an appointment to bring in your materials now!

Here are the steps you should take if you would like your student to return to Archway Glendale or if you are unsure at this time:

1. **Schedule your re-enrollment appointment by clicking [here](#).** Re-enrollment appointments are available on Monday, March 5th, Tuesday, March 6th, and Thursday, March 8th.
2. **On March 1st, log on to the [enrollment portal](#) and re-enroll your student.** Great Hearts will be sending out an email with re-enrollment instructions at 8am.
3. **Download your re-enrollment packet, make a copy of your AZ residency document (please be sure it lists the address where the student resides), and bring your materials to your scheduled appointment.**

If your student will not be returning to Archway Glendale, please complete these steps:

1. **On March 1st, log on to the enrollment website and select the option to withdraw your student.** Return the signed withdrawal form to the school office. No appointment is necessary.

For all, if you complete the steps above by March 8th, no further communications will be sent to you. Please email Erinn Mobley with any questions you might have.
