Important Dates

11/21 **HALF-DAY**

K-2 dismissed at 11:30 3-5 dismissed at 11:45

Doors for the first concert will open at 4:30 pm and all K -2 students must arrive by 4:45 pm. Students are required to stay for the entire concert

Third, fourth, and fifth grade will perform from 6:15 to 7 pm.

Doors will open at 5:50 pm and all 3 - 5 students must arrive between 5:50 and 6 pm. Students are required to stay for the entire concert.

Students in kindergarten through 4th grade should wear a clean school uniform. Students are not allowed to wear shorts and must not wear sweaters or sweatshirts while performing, please keep sweaters or sweatshirts with parents.

Students in 5th grade should wear concert attire.

Boys should wear a white collared shirt with black dress slacks and black dress shoes. Ties are optional.

Girls should wear a white blouse with a modest black skirt or black dress slacks and black dress shoes. A modest black dress is acceptable, as well. Open-toed shoes and reasonable heels are permitted.

Late Students, Drop Off and Pick Up

With the colder temperatures and darker skies in the morning, there has been an increase in tardy students. Please try to get to campus by 7:15 am to ensure your student is in his desk and ready to learn by 7:40 am.

Please use the queue to drop off and pick up students rather than using one of the surrounding neighborhood streets. Neighbors have been complaining and additional policemen may be on patrol. It is safer for families to use the queue than the surrounding streets.
