Re-Enrollment

Re-enrollment is here! This will be the time to indicate your child's intent to return to Archway Glendale for the 2020-2021 school year. Re-enrollment emails were sent by the Great Hearts Enrollment Team on Tuesday, March 3rd. Secure your child's seat by bringing all re-enrollment materials to the Glendale Prep gym during a pre-scheduled appointment on **March 18th, 19th, or 20th**. Please allow 15 minutes for the appointment. See you soon!

Reminders on what to do and prepare:

1. Sign up to come to one re-enrollment appointment per family. 20/21 Re-Enrollment Appointments

2. When re-enrolling via the Enrollment Portal, using a computer and Google Chrome is recommended.

3. Be sure all information in the portal is correct (phone numbers, addresses, etc.). If you update any information, please use the option to indicate you made changes so that your change may be easily identified.

4. Print the re-enrollment forms one-sided and bring them to your appointment.

5. Sign all the forms where applicable, before your appointment.

6. Get your AZ residency document ready. A driver's license or electric/water bill that lists the same address as the one listed on the re-enrollment forms works best. Bring it with you to your appointment.

7. Don't forget your Community Investment form.

Tips From The Nurse's Office

Many parents ask, "When is my child sick enough to stay home from school?" This is not an easy question to answer, but we hope these tips help!

A child who is sick will not perform well in school and is likely to spread illness to other children and staff. We suggest making an alternative plan so you will not be caught without a comforting place for your child to stay if he is ill.

Please keep your child home if he has any of the following symptoms:

1. **Fever-Temperature of 100 degrees Fahrenheit or higher.** Your child must be fever free (without the aid of fever reducing medicine) for 24 hours before returning to school.

2. **Cough and/or discolored nasal discharge.** A frequent, moist, productive cough, chest congestion, and/or nasal discharge that are not clear in color may be contagious and require treatment.

3. **Sore throat.** Especially with fever or swollen neck glands. If a student has a positive strep test, your student may return to school after a full 24 hours of antibiotics.

4. **Vomiting/Diarrhea.** Students with vomiting and/or diarrhea will not be able to attend school, remain at school or return to school for 24 hours.

5. **Eyes.** Thick mucus or pus draining from the eye or pink eye. With pink eye you may see white or yellow discharge, matted eyelids after sleep, pain, redness or itching. Your child must receive 24 hours of antibiotics before returning to school.

6. **Rash.** Especially with fever or itching. Any child with an undiagnosed rash will not be allowed at school.

If your child exhibits any of these symptoms while at school, you will be notified, and your child will be sent home to recover. Please contact the school nurse's if you have any questions or concerns. <u>Mrs. Dela-Cruz</u> or <u>Mrs. Madeya</u>
