1. Purchase Student Materials (different from School Supplies)

These materials include the Singapore books, Spalding notebooks, literature books, etc. Purchased materials will be delivered to your student's classroom before school begins. 2. Purchase Uniforms

Our uniform vendor, [Anton Uniforms](#), is offering 20% off until June 15th and free shipping. They will also accept returns through September 1st. There are size charts available on their website. 4. Apply to be a Volunteer

Do you want to chaperone on a field trip, help with Read-a-thon, volunteer in the classroom or lunch room? Apply to volunteer today! All volunteers are required to submit a Volunteer Application each year, rather than being fingerprinted every few years or submitting a Level 1 Arizona Fingerprint Clearance card. The cost is \$5.00, and the process is very quick. It should take about 10 minutes to fill out the application, and results will be emailed to volunteers within 48 hours. Please note:

1. On the personal information screen, "Affiliation" references the relationship the person has to the student. Under Student Name, please list all Archway Glendale and Glendale Prep student names.
2. On the school preferences screen, please choose Great Hearts Glendale for Archway Glendale and Glendale Prep.
3. On the functions page, please note that "Functions" references activities and that all activities ARE NOT available at Archway Glendale. Archway Glendale options DO NOT include: Athletics, Concessions, Student Services, or Field Trip (please choose Chaperone instead). Glendale Prep may offer some of the options Archway Glendale does not.

4. On the disclaimer page, please note that ALL volunteer activities at Archway Glendale require a background check and therefore a social security number.

4. On the payment page, please note that the fee for ALL activities (a.k.a functions) is \$5.00.

Please reach out to the school office with any questions or concerns.

The Archway Glendale campus will remain a closed campus, meaning that visitors and volunteers are not allowed to be on campus unless prior arrangements have been made. All visitors and volunteers will be required to present an ID upon entry to the campus.

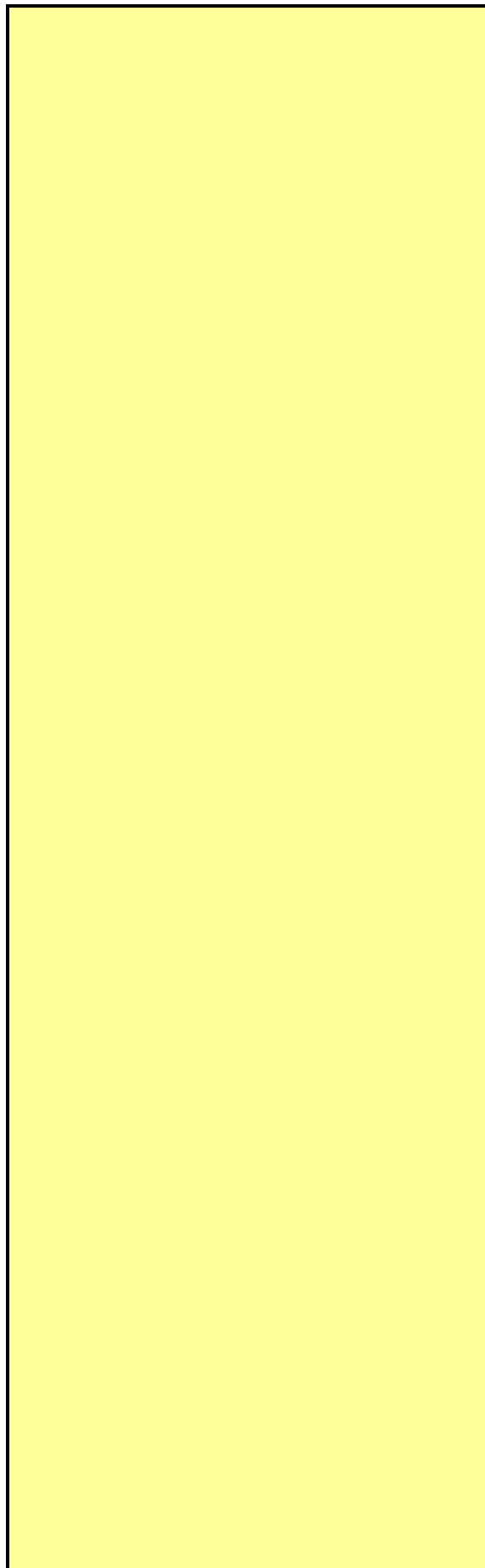
School Office
