## First Day of School, 20/21 School Year

All Archway Glendale students will start school via Distance Learning on Thursday, August 6th.

Families who choose the brick and mortar option can plan on students returning to campus on Thursday, August 27th, unless the governor extends the closure.

Families who choose distance learning may return to campus after the first quarter. Please note that distance learners who return to campus may be assigned to a different teacher when they return.

## **Not Returning to Archway Glendale**

If you decide you would prefer enrolling your student in a school that specializes in online instruction or a district school that might be partnering with a school that specializes in online learning, please know that you will need to withdraw your student(s) from Archway Glendale. The State does not allow students to be enrolled in two schools concurrently. If you decide not to return to Archway Glendale, please notify Mrs. Fleming as soon as possible. If you withdraw from, then later decide to return to, Archway Glendale, you will need to fill out a new application for each student.

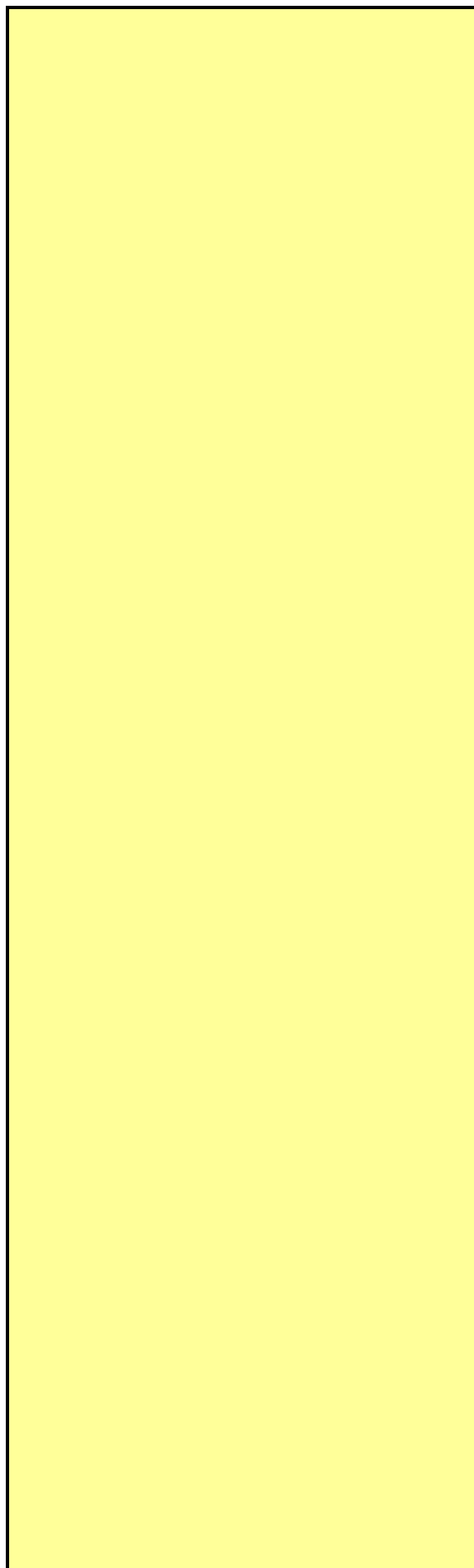
## **Community Investment**

## **Message From Mr. Kersting**

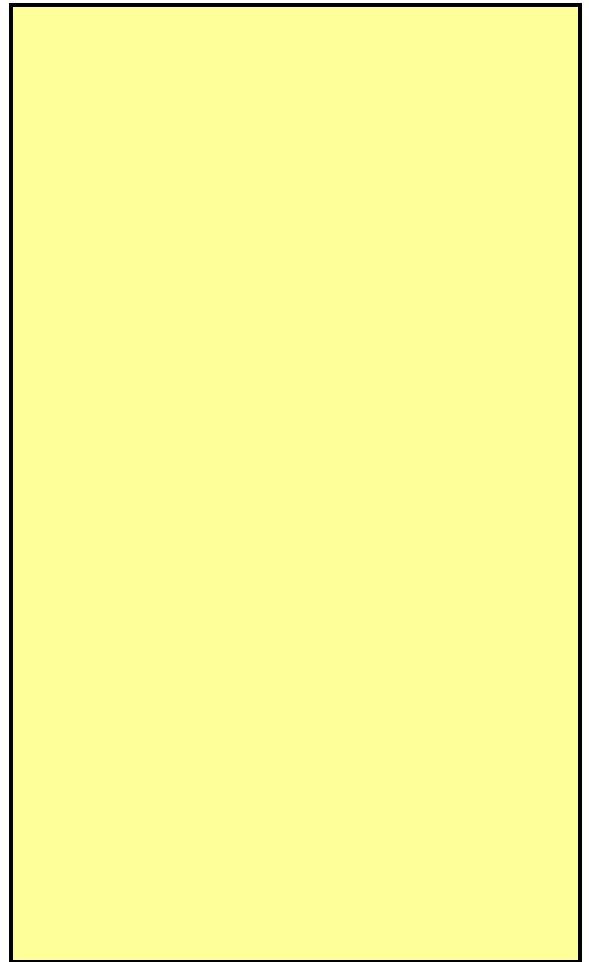
