Dress-up Day Guidelines

- 1. Student costumes must represent a literacy/historical figure that is part of the Archway Glendale curriculum, or a character from a book in the library.
- 2. Student costumes need to follow the same guidelines as the uniform policy. Reference page 44 of the family handbook.
- 3. Items in the costume should not have any logos, brand names, and/or pop culture on them.
- 4. Students may wear non-uniform shoes (such as sandals), provided they are appropriate for your character and safe for outdoor play.
- 5. Small props are allowed but should be put away during class.
- 6. Students who do not follow the costume guidelines may be sent home or may be asked to change into the school uniform.
- 7. Students are not required to dress up.
- 8. Students should be careful not to wear any costume that could be offensive to others.
- 9. Costumes need to be approved by the homeroom teacher no later than October 23rd.
