SARRC Screening

For the past couple of years, Archway Glendale has been working together with the Southwest Autism Research and Resource Center (SARRC) on a research project regarding a universal screening for social challenges designed to be implemented in public schools. Every student in 2nd and 4th grade at Archway Glendale will be screened by their teachers during the week of November 15th. The screening involves a form to be filled out by their teachers based on classroom observations and does not involve pulling students from class. Please read this letter from Christopher Smith, Vice President and Director of Research at SARRC, for more information about the screening, and read the answers to frequently asked questions which are available here. Please note that your child's identifying information will *not* be shared with SARRC. If additional evaluations are suggested after the screening, we will contact you for permission to share your contact information. If you wish to opt out of the screening, please complete the form here. Opting out needs to take place by November 10th. GREAT HEARTS OPEN ENROLLMENT:

Do you have a current Archway Glendale 5th grader? Do you have a child that will start kindergarten for the 22/23 school year? If you answered yes to either of these questions, please add Great Hearts Open Enrollment (11/8 to 12/10) to your calendar.

Families with current Archway Glendale 5th graders will need to apply for 6th grade at Glendale Prep during open enrollment. This will assure that their students receive the Archway Graduate Priority at Glendale Prep for the 22/23 school year.

Current Archway Glendale Families with children that turn five by 9/1/22, will need to apply during open enrollment to be sure their child receives Sibling Priority and has the best chance of getting a seat at Archway Glendale for the 22/23 school year.

Current Kindergarten - 4th-grade students will participate in Re-Enrollment in March 2022.

What Are All These Portals?

Archway Glendale and Great Hearts use many different portals. It can be confusing to know which portal to use for what. Hopefully, the list below will help you:

<u>Enrollment Portal</u>: The Enrollment Portal is used to apply for enrollment or to re-enroll in a Great Hearts school.

<u>Payment Portal</u>: The Payment Portal is unique to Archway Glendale and is where you will go to purchase Student Materials, register for clubs and other special events, etc. If you have students at other Great Hearts schools, you will have a separate Payment Portal for each school. Please note there is also a Great Hearts Payment Portal used for students who attend Athenaeum.

<u>Great Hearts Parent Portal</u>: The Great Hearts Parent Portal is used to access grades for each of your students no matter how many Great
