The narrative evaluation is much more meaningful than the assignment of a single letter grade or a percentage.

Please use your discretion as your child's primary educator in determining the appropriateness of showing your child his report card. The report card is meant to be a communication tool between you and your child's teacher. You should decide whether it will help or hinder your child's learning to view the report card.

Use the link above to be sure you are able to log in to the Great Hearts Parent Portal. There should be only one account per family for all students who attend a Great Hearts School. For example, if you have students at both Archway Glendale and Glendale Prep, their report cards will be under the same account. Google Chrome or Firefox are the best browsers to use.
