Archway Glendale Quarter 2 Report Cards are now live on the Great Hearts Parent Portal.

Report Card Details - Quarter 2 Report Cards are unique in that they contain a lengthier narrative evaluation. A liberal arts education requires a special kind of evaluation - one that offers a narrative account of the student's development in sense of wonder, depth of inquiry, participation, specific areas of mastery and needs for improvement, and dispositions toward learning and towards teachers and fellow students. The narrative evaluation is much more meaningful than the assignment of a single letter grade or a percentage.

Please use your discretion as your child's primary educator in determining the appropriateness of showing your child his report card. The report card is meant to be a communication tool between you and your child's teacher. You should decide whether it will help or hinder your child's learning to view the report card.

Use the link above to be sure you are able to log in to the Great Hearts Parent Portal. There should be only one account per family for all students who attend a Great Hearts School. For example, if you have students at both Archway Glendale and Glendale Prep, their report cards will be under the same account. Google Chrome or Firefox are the best browsers to use. If you do not remember your Password, please click on the "Forgot Password" button. Please note, the password reset email may take up to 24 hours to receive. What Are All These Portals?

Archway Glendale and Great Hearts use many different portals. It can be confusing to know which portal to use for what. Hopefully, the list below will help you:

Enrollment Portal: The Enrollment Portal is used to apply for enrollment or to re-enroll in a Great Hearts school.

Payment Portal: The Payment Portal is unique to Archway Glendale and is where you will go to purchase Student Materials, register for clubs and other special events, etc. If you have students at other Great Hearts schools, you will have a separate Payment Portal for each school. Please note there is also a Great Hearts Payment Portal used for students who attend Athenaeum.

<u>Great Hearts Parent Portal</u>: The Great Hearts Parent Portal is used to access grades for each of your students no matter how many Great Hearts schools they might attend. The Great Hearts Parent Portal is open 4 times a year for parents to view report cards.

Lost and Found

If your student has lost an item at school, please be sure to send them to the Archway Glendale Lost and Found. It is located right outside the school library and can be checked before or after school or by asking a teacher for permission. Clearly labeled items are returned to the student's

classroom. ALL items that were not claimed before Winter Break have been donated or discarded.

Parents are welcome to check the lost and found themselves. Please come to the school office to sign in (make sure to bring your ID).
