Headmaster Corner

Dear Archway Glendale Families

As we strengthen our roots, Archway Glendale remains committed to the importance of homework. Homework is a key way for students to strengthen and reinforce concepts learned in class. Research provides strong evidence that the right kind and quantity of homework benefits student learning. No homework, or too little homework, does not maximize student learning.

Elementary school homework requires parental involvement. Emerging and developing readers require nightly parental practice to build the critical skill of reading. Spalding homework requires a parent to dictate the Spalding words to the student. Parental support in learning math facts, preparing for poetry recitations, and studying for tests is also critical for success. Parents can also help students set up systems that assure their success in monitoring their own homework completion.

As important as homework is for school success, the family ritual of reading together each night is very important. Studies show an extremely high correlation of school learning success and students whose parents read to or with them regularly.

Homework success goes a long way toward assuring school success and student growth in virtue, knowledge, and academic skills.
