 - o Gentlemen: black dress slacks, black button-down shirt, black belt, black socks, black dress shoes, and (optional) black tie/bowtie.

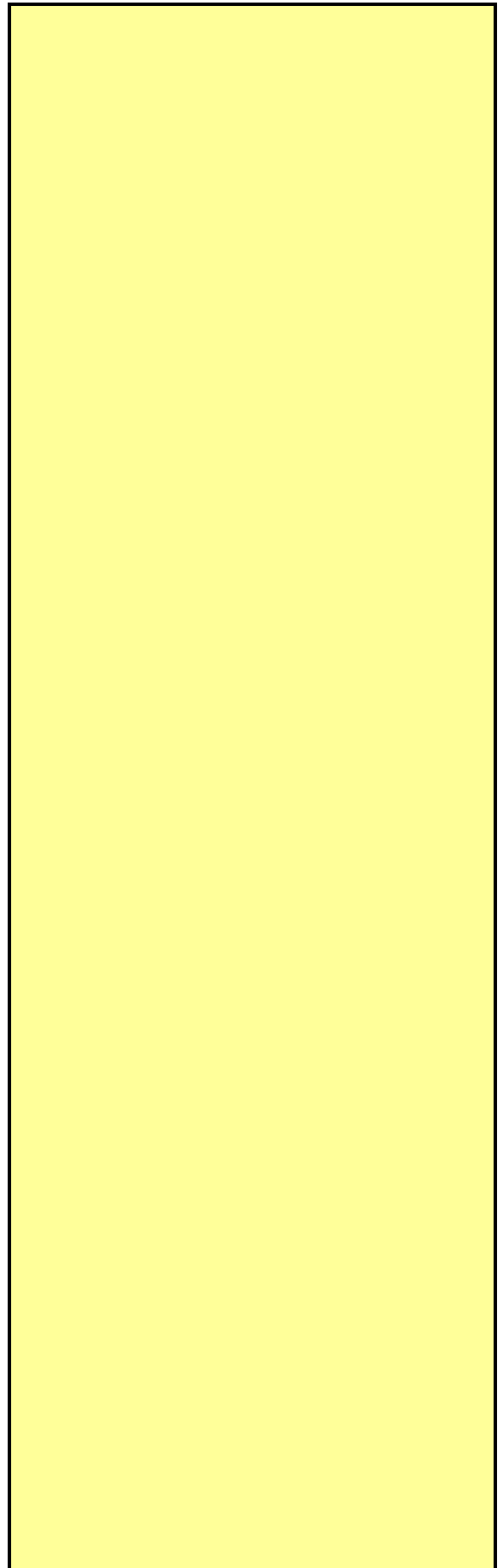

Dear Archway Glendale Families,

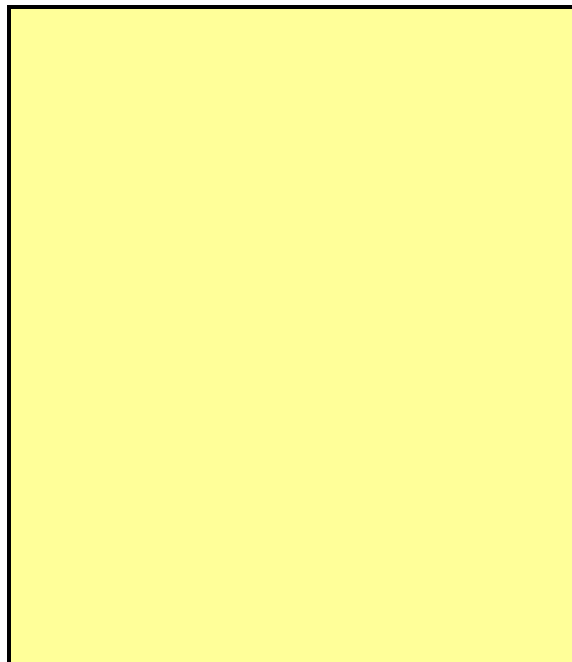

