Re-Enroll Now

Your student's seat may not be secure for the 22/23 school year until re-enrollment is complete.

- 2. Once in the Enrollment Portal, please click on the blue RE-ENROLL NOW button on the right.
- 3. Select a student, click on the blue SHOW APPLICATIONS button, then the green START RE-ENROLLMENT button.
- 4. Answer all questions, download the forms, and **print one-sided**. Double-check the information for accuracy

- Repeat steps 3 and 4 for each applicable student.

- 5. Make sure you have everything ready! You will need the re-enrollment forms printed **one-sided** and one document to prove AZ residency. A current driver's license, or electric, water, or gas billing statement work great (the address on the residency document must match the address on the reenrollment form).
- 6. Bring the re-enrollment forms to your scheduled appointment date and time in the Glendale Prep Gym Lobby.

For withdrawing students: please follow the steps below:

- 1. Please follow steps 1 through 3 from above.
- 2. Download and print out the withdrawal form.
- Sign the withdrawal form and return it to the school office or email it to Mrs. Fleming at <u>kfleming@archwayglendale.org</u> by Thursday, March 10. This will not affect your child's current 21/22 enrollment.

Once all re-enrollment forms have been submitted, you will receive a confirmation email. Archway Glendale would like to see all families return for the 22/23 school year.
