Headmaster Corner


Dear Archway Glendale Families,

Over the last few weeks we have received several compliments from different parties that involved a common thread. On the last several field trips, the proprietors told our teachers that our students were the most polite and well behaved students they have had to their location. A prospective parent shared with me that she can tell a difference in the Great Hearts children on her block because of the polite way they behave and play with friends when visiting her house. My husband served pizza for two hours at the Spring Festival, and he commented that every single student said please and thank you unprompted and waited in line patiently. I believe the most important question on the recent family survey was regarding students being kind to one another, and I am pleased to share that we scored very high in this category, well above the Great Hearts network score.

Of course children make mistakes as they grow in virtue, and we use these mistakes as learning opportunities to grow and become better. But for the most part, I am perpetually awed by how good, kind, caring, giving, and loving our students are. I have deeply pondered what we are specifically doing that helps form such loving and lovable children. Of course the leading cause is that we have wonderful families that raise their children in love and goodness. As a school, I think there is a combination of things we are doing right that are helping develop kindness in our scholars: a continued focus on our mission and the virtues, having two teachers in each class to give individualized coaching to students, the use of Love and Logic as our core discipline method, beautiful literature that builds the moral imagination, a rigorous and wonder-building curriculum, and forming good habits of speech and behavior to the point they are second nature.

We must never rest on our laurels though. We must continually strive to nurture kindness and virtue in our scholars.
