# **Back to School Checklist. Are You Ready?**

The 22/23 school year begins on Thursday, August 4th. Use the checklist below to be sure your student is ready.

- 1. Purchase uniforms, shoes, backpacks, lunch boxes and water bottles.
  - Anton Uniforms provides uniforms for Archway Glendale. Please
    be sure to purchase approved shirts from Anton Uniforms. Jumpers
    (kinder-2nd grade), pants, shorts, and skirts (3rd 5th grade) may be
    purchased from other vendors as long as they match the items
    Anton Uniforms sells. Please review the Uniform Policy in the
    Archway Glendale Family Handbook for details.
  - Archway Glendale is now partnering with R & L Embroidery to offer approved uniform patches. You may now purchase a uniform shirt from any vendor as long as it is indistinguishable from the Anton Uniforms shirts (pique knit shirt). Take the shirts to R & L Embroidery at 3143 E Greenway Rd #803 to get a patch sewn on. The cost is \$7. Store hours are Monday Friday from 9 am to 5:30 pm and Saturday and Sunday from 10 am to 4 pm.
  - The Archway Glendale PSO will host a Back to School Used Uniform Sale/Exchange on Saturday, July 23rd, from 8:30 to 11 am. Please sign-up to attend or volunteer: <u>Archway Glendale Back to School Used Uniform Sale/Exchange</u>
  - Students are required to wear all black shoes to school. Click <u>here</u> to view some samples.
  - Backpacks, lunch boxes, and water bottles should be free of pop culture or offensive images. Please refer to the <u>Archway Glendale</u> Family Handbook for details.
  - Please be sure to label ALL items clearly with your student's name.
- 2. Purchase school supplies and Student Materials.
  - If you did not order a Schoolkidz school supply kit in May, please be sure to purchase school supplies and bring them to Meet the Teacher. Scroll down on the link provided to see the supply lists. Again, supplies include folders, crayons, pencils, scissors, etc.

### What Are All These Portals?

Archway Glendale and Great Hearts use many different portals. It can be confusing to know which portal to use for what. Hopefully, this list will help you:

<u>Enrollment Portal</u>: The Enrollment Portal is used to apply for enrollment or to re-enroll in a Great Hearts school.

Payment Portal: The Archway Glendale Payment Portal is unique to Archway Glendale and is where you will go to purchase Student Materials, register for clubs and other special events, etc. If you have students at other Great Hearts schools, you will have a separate Payment Portal for each school. Please note there is also a Great Hearts Payment Portal used for students who attend Athenaeum. If your 5th grader is playing middle school sports for Glendale Prep or if you enroll a child in The Griffin Experience, you will use the Payment Portal for Glendale Prep.

Great Hearts Parent Portal: The Great Hearts Parent Portal is used to access grades for each of your students no matter how many Great Hearts schools they might attend. The Great Hearts Parent Portal is open 4 times a year for parents to view report cards.
